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**Empanelment of suppliers for supply of 10330 MTs of Whole Meal Wheat  
Atta in 1 Kg Manufacturer brand in secondary bag of 50 KG under  
Chandranna Sankranthi Kanuka-2018 by Government of Andhra Pradesh**

The APSCSCL has invited applications from the eligible Whole Meal Wheat Atta Manufacturers for enrolment as registered suppliers for supply of Whole Meal Wheat Atta in 1 Kg packet form in secondary bag of 50 Kg. The procedure for enrolment, registration and terms and conditions of supply under the e-procurement mode for supply of Whole Meal Wheat Atta is detailed below:-

APSCSCL shall follow e-procurement mode and has entrusted the same to Tenderwizard (formerly TENDERWIZARD for conducting electronic auction system for procurement of Whole Meal Wheat Atta from registered suppliers.

**1. SCOPE OF WORK:-**

1.1. The APSCSCL Ltd being the appointed agency for procurement of Whole Meal Wheat Atta by Government of Andhra Pradesh proposes to procure the Whole Meal Wheat Atta under the scheme from the Manufacturers only through e-procurement process.

1.2. **The requirement of Whole Meal Wheat Atta under Chandranna Sankranthi Kanuka 2018 is approximately 10330 Metric Tons, which is to be supplied to the MLS points of (9) districts Zone-wise in AP State.** The list of Zones and the approximate quantity of the Whole Meal Wheat Atta required may be seen in Annexure-1. The quantities indicated in respect of each district may vary depending upon the requirement and demand as indicated by the department from time to time. **The e-Reverse Auction will be conducted Zone-wise.**

1.3. The Whole Meal Wheat Atta will be procured from the registered Whole Meal Wheat Atta Manufacturers only as per the eligibility criteria mentioned in Section-2.

1.4. In order to facilitate Whole Meal Wheat Atta Manufacturers to participate in e-procurement process, registration with Tenderwizard is mandatory. The procedure for registration with Tenderwizard is detailed in Annexure-2.

1.5. The inspection and evaluation of samples will be carried out in accordance with specified quality parameters as per the procedure stipulated in clause-7.

1.6. After satisfactory supply of the tendered items by the Successful Bidder within the stipulated time, Payment will be released by APSCSC Ltd to the suppliers within 10-15 working days from date of submission of bills as per the procedure stipulated in clause-11 through Tender Wizard platform to the respective account of the suppliers by electronic fund transfer.

1.7 The procedure for enrolment and registration of suppliers, terms and conditions of supply of Whole Meal Wheat Atta is detailed below. Some of the clauses to these terms & conditions may be amended if necessary, prior to the conduct of e-Auction. Details of such amendments will be uploaded in the website [www.apscsc.gov.in](http://www.apscsc.gov.in) for the information of participants.

## **2. ELIGIBILITY / PREQUALIFICATION CONDITIONS.**

2.1. Manufacturers of Whole Meal Wheat Atta are only eligible to apply for registration as registered suppliers.

2.2. The Whole Meal Wheat Atta Manufacturing Unit/s should be owned or leased by the registered supplier. In respect of Whole Meal Wheat Atta Manufacturing Units which are leased, the lease agreement should be legally registered with the competent authority.

2.3. The suppliers should have valid trade licence, import licence (if applicable), GST Tax registration (if applicable) issued by the concerned authorities. They should be in operation for past two years.

2.4. The bidders should have adequate secured storage facility to store minimum 100 Metric Tones of Whole Meal Wheat Atta.

2.5. The Whole Meal Wheat Atta Manufacturing Units should have proper valid license by the concerned authority for manufacturing / processing and storing of Whole Meal Wheat Atta.

2.6. The Whole Meal Wheat Atta Manufacturing Units should have been in operation for at least past three years. They should possess valid GST Tax registration issued by concerned authorities.

2.7 The firm / applicant and its sister concern units/Associates should not have been Blacklisted / convicted for any offences or violation of any State or Central act such as essential commodities act etc or any criminal offence under IPC. They should not have been blacklisted by this Corporation or any Govt./PSU Agency.

2.8 The suppliers and their associates who were penalized and black listed and whose cases are in litigation during the supplies of Chandranna Sankranthi Kanuka and Chandranna Ramzan Tohfa of 2015, 2016, 2017 and other Govt. schemes are not eligible to participate in the tenders.

2.9 The annual turnover should not be less than 30.00 (Thirty) crore per annum during the last 3 years.

3.0 Supplier should possess valid **fssai Certificate**.

3.1 The Tenderers should have an experience of (3) years in supplies of Wheat Atta to any Govt. Agencies.

### **3.DOCUMENTS TO BE FURNISHED ALONG WITH APPLICATION FOR REGISTRATION.**

3.1 The Whole Meal Wheat Atta Manufacturing Units should have proper valid license by the concerned authority for manufacturing / processing and storing of Wheat- Copy of which will have to be furnished.

3.2 Attested copy of audited balance Sheet and profit / loss account for past two years duly certified by Chartered Accountant if it is a own manufacturing unit. In case of a leased unit, the above documents of both the entities i.e. lesser and lessee will have to be furnished.

3.3 Applicants shall submit attested copy of the Income Tax returns of last two years with a copy of a PAN card attested by authorized signatory.

3.4 Attested copy of Certificate of registration under Excise, GST Tax as applicable.

3.5 An affidavit on Rs 100 non judicial stamp paper and Notarized, regarding

3.5.1. Not having been prosecuted for violation rules / law under Essential Commodities Act or any such others law or orders there under in any court of law.

3.5.2. Not having been black listed by any organization or Government for non-performance of contractual obligation.

3.6 In case of partnership firm or Co-operative or Corporate, the Whole Meal Wheat Atta Manufacturing Units should furnish a copy of the partnership deed or byelaw or memorandum as the case may be. In case of partnership firms the share holding pattern should be duly certified by the Chartered Accountant along with details of name, age, education and experience of the partners. In case of Co operative / corporate body copy of letter of authorization to the Chief Executive or the authorized person to register and participate in the e-procurement/tender process should be furnished.

3.7 In case of supplier who has entered in to lease agreement with the Whole Meal Wheat Atta Manufacturing Units the copy of the legally registered lease agreement duly certified by the Chartered Accountant shall be enclosed. The existing lease agreement should have the validity for the past (3) years from the date of participation in the tenders.

3.8 The Whole Meal Wheat Atta Manufacturing Units should furnish letter of authority or power of attorney for having authorized the person to sign the documents on behalf of firm or society or corporate body. Attestation of signature of such authorized signatory from the bank where the firm is having its account is essential.

3.9 The address proof of the authorized signatory viz Telephone bill/copy of pass port / electricity bill/ voter ID proof should be submitted along with the application. The address proof in respect of the firm shall be either certificate of registration or certificate of incorporation issued by the concerned authority.

3.10 Bank account details of firm along with IFSC code, Branch details, address shall be furnished in the letterhead of the firm.

3.11 The new applicants have to deposit the registration fee of Rs 3500/- and applicable GST along with the documents. The registration fee can be directly transferred to the Exchange bank account given below. The members will be allowed to participate in

APSCSCL auction of Whole Meal Wheat Atta only for the year 2017-18. The existing members (TCM/CP) of Tender Wizard, who have renewed the membership for the year 2016-17 need not pay registration fee to Tender Wizard. However they have to submit the relevant signed documents, Annexure 2 and Notarized Affidavit.

3.12 The application for registration and terms and condition with relevant Annexure can be downloaded from the website [www.apscsc.gov.in](http://www.apscsc.gov.in). Requests for forwarding applications through post / couriers will not be entertained.

#### **4. EVALUATION OF APPLICATION FOR REGISTRATION.**

4.1. Duly filled application to be submitted by Bidder Online at [www.tenderwizard.com](http://www.tenderwizard.com) /APCS with relevant documents and Registration fee on or before 1.00 pm of 10.11.2017.

Note: The submitted documents if found correct, the USER ID and PASSWORD will be enabled within 24 Working Hours. If submitted documents found incorrect, the USER ID and PASSWORD will be kept on hold and will be enabled only after receiving clarification from the Bidder.

4.2 Eligible suppliers will be issued with User ID and Password by Tender Wizard after evaluating the documents & receipt of the registration fee.

4.3. Such registered suppliers are eligible to participate on electronic bidding system (e-auction) for Whole Meal Wheat Atta conducted by Tender Wizard as and when scheduled.

#### **5. SCHEDULING OF E-AUCTIONS.**

5.1 Based on the requirements, APSCSCL through their Head Office will notify Tender Wizard to schedule auctions on periodic basis. Further such details will be posted on the web site of APSCSCL [www.apscsc.gov.in](http://www.apscsc.gov.in) Neither the APSCSCL nor TenderWizard will individually intimate to the registered suppliers regarding the e-auction schedule.

5.2. All registered suppliers are eligible to participate in e-auctions subject to terms and conditions detailed in this document.

## **6.QUALITY PARAMETERS.**

### **6.1QUALITY SPECIFICATIONS OF WHOLE MEAL WHEAT ATTA**

Wheat Atta should conform to the provisions of the FSS Act and Rules/Regulations. Atta or resultant Atta means the coarse product obtained by milling or grinding clean wheat free from pest, rodent hair and excreta.

Whole Meal Wheat Atta shall have a characteristic taste and smell and be fit in all respects for human consumption. It shall conform to the following standards.

Only good quality of whole meal wheat Atta under the FSSA, 2006 Rules & Regulations strictly conforming to the specifications as detailed above will be accepted.

Stocks not conforming to specifications shall stand summarily rejected and it is the responsibility of the supplier/Tenderer to take back the rejected stocks within no time immediately and replace them with stocks of required quality specification at his own risk and cost.

**SPECIFICATIONS OF ONE KG. POLYTHENE PACKS,  
DESIGN, PRINTING, ETC.**

1. Size of one Kg. Polythene Pack shall be 41x29 cms. having a weight of 9-10 gms.
2. Thickness gauge shall be 12 pet + 60 transparent poly pet quality.
3. Polythene shall be of transparent quality only.
4. Pouch shall be of Centre Sealing and shall withstand bursting test.
5. Details of Batch No., Date of Packing, Best before 6 months from date of Mfg. shall be prominently displayed.
6. Net Weight of the pack should be 1Kg.
7. Stocks should be delivered in New Polypropylene bags with a capacity to pack 50 packets of 1 Kg Whole Meal Wheat Atta should be of high quality as per the standards conforming to FSSAI. The Licence Number should be mentioned on the 1 Kg packet.
8. All information as per standards of Weights & Measures Act 1936 & the Standards of Weights and Measures(Packaged commodities) Rules, 1937 and Food Safety & Standards Act, 2006 and Regulations there under. The tenderer shall mention on each Polypropylene bag of Whole Meal Wheat Atta supplied, name and full address of Mill, name of the commodity besides the following.

Date and month & year of packing

Under CSK for Andhra Pradesh

The material used for packaging of Wheat Atta in new Polypropylene Bag should be of high quality as per the standards conforming to FSSAI.

- 6.3 Payment will be made on net weight only.
- 6.4 Packing should be one side transparent and commodity visible. Any deviation will be viewed seriously and severe action will be initiated against the supplies.
- 6.5 The shelf life of whole meal wheat atta should be more than the period of (6) Months.

6.5. The Successful qualified suppliers will be solely responsible for consequences for any violation of the Food Safety and Standards Act 2011 and Indian Standard Specification no: IS 5982 : 2003 and BIS Standard IS 498 : 2003 or any other connected rules with regards to adulteration and the Refined.

6.6. Suppliers shall be liable for any action or consequences that may arise due to non-adherence to quality parameters.

6.7. Apart from the above, in the event of any harm caused due to supply of bad quality, the concerned supplier shall be held solely responsible of any losses/damages to the events arising out of such supplies under the scheme.

6.8 Every batch manufactured and marked for supply lot wise shall be subjected to inspection, testing and certification by an assaying agency accredited by NABL/State Food Laboratory. The batch wise assaying report shall be submitted to the APSCSCL. The list of accredited labs of NABL from whom the Assaying report has to be obtained is as detailed in Annexure 3. Suppliers may check with the Assaying agencies listed in annexure-4 that have the scope of accreditation to certify Whole Meal Wheat Atta.

## **7. ASSAYING**

7.1 The Supplier shall, on his own and at his cost, offer the stock of Whole Meal Wheat Atta from the identified batch marked for delivery at the loading point for inspection and certification in accordance with quality parameters as specified in Clause 6.2 above, from any of the NABL accredited food testing laboratories as per the list notified by Food Safety and Standards Authority of India. Please refer to Annexure – 3 for the list of laboratories. The stocks which qualify the parameters as per Clause-6.2 above shall only be supplied. Each and every consignment shall accompany such Assaying Certificate issued by NABL/State Food Laboratory accredited food testing laboratory.

7.2 APSCSCL may randomly collect the samples at the depots and get the samples tested in any of the NABL accredited laboratories independently immediately from the day of delivery by the supplier. The quality of Whole Meal Wheat Atta will be evaluated based on specified quality parameters as detailed in section-6.2. The results of such testing will be final and binding on the suppliers. The stocks which fail the test have to be taken back and replaced by new stock by the Supplier at his own cost within one week from the date of intimation by the respective District Manager of APSCSCL.

Suppliers may note that the cost of assaying will be borne by them if the sample fails in the test and such costs will be deducted while making the payment for supplies made. However if the test results shows the sample is as per the specifications, the APSCSCL will bear the cost of assaying.

7.3 The supplier shall arrange to record tare weight and gross weight on electronic weighbridge before loading and after loading of the consignment. The copies of weigh bridge receipt along with copy of invoice / delivery challan and assaying report from the NABL accredited laboratories as per list detailed in Annexure 3 shall be handed over to concerned officer of the APSCSCL at the time of giving delivery. Deliveries without valid documents will be rejected and will not be inwarded by the concerned officer.

7.4 Consignment will be unloaded at the designated warehouse during working hours only i.e. between 10 AM and 5 PM. On arrival of the consignment the concerned officer of APSCSCL will verify the documents and the assaying report. On confirming the authenticity of the consignment and after being satisfied with the quality of Whole Meal Wheat Atta based on the assaying report submitted by the Supplier, the concerned officer directs the representative of the supplier to arrange for recording the gross weight of the consignment on an electronic weighbridge before unloading.

7.5 In case if the concerned officer of APSCSCL is not satisfied with the quality of Chana Dal supplied then he would arrange to draw samples and refer the same for testing and certification as per Clause 7.2 above immediately after receipt of the goods.

7.6 After unloading, the tare weight of the truck is recorded on the same electronic weighbridge. The copies of the Weigh Bridge receipts at the unloading point along with other documents i.e. invoice / delivery challan, assaying report and weighbridge receipts at the loading point shall be handed over to the concerned officer of APSCSC Ltd.

7.7 In case of non-availability of electronic weighbridge facility in the vicinity of the delivery location, then the Depot Manager shall record the gross weight of the bags on weighing scale on a random basis. Based on the recorded weights he shall arrive at net weight of the consignment duly deducting weight of the bags.

**7(a) Assaying by Third Party:**

The APSCSCL is at liberty to appoint Third Party for collection of random samples of the commodity from out of the stocks supplied by the supplier for quality test and the supplier shall bind over the results. Any deviation in quality specification prescribed, the

supplier shall be penalized appropriately at the sole discretion of VC& Managing Director, APSCSCL, Hyderabad.

#### **8. PROCESS OF ELECTRONIC AUCTION SYSTEM ON TENDER WIZARD PLATFORM.**

8.1. The registered suppliers with Tender Wizard are eligible to participate in the electronic bid system i.e. e-auction with the issued USER ID and PASSWORD.

8.2. Tender Wizard in consultation with the APSCSCL will schedule the auctions for each month and such details viz. e-auction calendar will be published on the website of APSCSCL Ltd.

8.3. The registered suppliers shall not be intimated individually regarding the e-auctions, which are scheduled by the Tender Wizard. However the registered suppliers may contact, APSCSCL office located at Hyderabad for obtaining details of schedule of e-auctions.

8.4. The registered suppliers need to deposit 2% (Two per cent) of the value of goods as EMD (margin money) with the Tender Wizard accounts to participate in the e auctions as given below:

For the E-Auction by way of:

- RTGS/NEFT Transfer
- E-Payment (Electronic Mode)

8.5 The bidders shall be allowed by Tender Wizard to bid only if the requisite EMD amount is available in the Common Exchange EMD Account of Tender Wizard. The amount deposited as E.M.D (Margin Money) would determine the bidding capacity of the bidder.

8.7 Only the EMD (Margin Money) of the lowest bidder would be blocked by Tender Wizard. The EMD (Margin Money) of the unsuccessful Bidder(s), including those whose bid(s) are not accepted due to non-fulfillment/not meeting the conditions attached to the bid(s), shall be returned by Tender Wizard on the withdrawal request made by the bidder through CS Tracker Module latest by one day from the day of close of e-Auction.

8.8 In case, if any bid is received 3 minutes prior to the scheduled auction closing time then the auction schedule shall be extended for 5 minutes over and above the schedule auction closing time. There shall be maximum 3 such extensions.

8.9 The bidders shall place their bids online on Tenderwizard Platform **www.tenderwizard.com/APCS** the online trading system made available by Tender Wizard as per the terms and conditions of the E-Auction.

8.10 Price to be quoted in delivered weight and quality basis, as per the quality specified for a particular month. The evaluation and finalization of bids received shall be made on the basis of the lowest price quoted by the bidders for the lot.

8.11 The price quoted shall be per 100 Kilograms (Quintal) basis for entire quantity.

**8.11.1 In respect of Suppliers within the State of AP or outside the State of AP the price quoted shall be:**

- a) Inclusive of all incidental expenditure, transaction charges, Custom duty, Excise duty, cess, Education cess, applicable GST if any, payable for delivery at MLS points in the district of AP.
- b) Inclusive of cost of packing, transportation charges, weighbridge charges, assaying charges, Tender Wizard transaction charges to wholesale points of MLS points in the district of AP & transit insurance till MLS points of Corporation respect of the concerned district.

8.12 The Bids of all Bidders who have participated in the e-Auction must remain valid for maximum period of 7 (seven) working days from the date of auction.

8.13 The reducing tick size shall be Rs. 1. (Rupees one only)

8.14 During an auction session, a bidder may modify his bid downwards to a reduced value less than the existing lowest bid. No cancellation of Bids shall be allowed during an auction session. The lowest valid bid received on the platform will be communicated to the department by Tenderwizard. The Corporation after evaluation of bids will communicate regarding acceptance/rejection of the lowest bid (if found not competitive). The lowest valid bid once approved by the APSCSCL will be declared as successful L-1 bidder and

the same will be communicated by e-mail to the successful bidder .APSCSCL reserves the right, without giving any reason, to accept or to reject all or any bid including lowest bid.

8.15 The final results of the e-Auction as approved by APSCSCL are binding on all bidders. Any requests for cancellation of bids received either during the auction session or after the conclusion of an auction session shall not be accepted. Failure to accept award of supply contract by the successful supplier shall result in the forfeiture of the EMD (Margin money) and blacklisting from further participation in the e-auctions for a period of three years. The decision of the VC& Managing Director, APSCSCL in this regard will be final.

8.16 Any bid placed using the bidders username and the password shall be deemed to be an unconditional binding of the bidder to whom such username and the password has been allotted by Tender Wizard, inter-alia, for the purpose of the e-Auction and the bidder shall be solely and fully responsible for all the activities that occur under such username and password. The user is therefore advised to check the username and the password before the E-auction and is advised not to reveal it to anyone else so as to prevent misuse of the same. It is further suggested that Suppliers are requested to change the password frequently to protect from misuse.

8.17 APSCSCL & Tender Wizard shall not be responsible for any failure of power, Network, Server, Bandwidth problems, Hosting Server, Internet Connectivity, ISP or otherwise or the slowness to access Tenderwizard Platform/Exchange Platform [www.tenderwizard.com/APCS](http://www.tenderwizard.com/APCS). In case if e-Auctions cannot be held on scheduled date due to Server problems, the e-Auctions will be rescheduled and will be held on alternative day, the details of such date/s will be notified in the website of APSCSCL and TENDERWIZARD.

8.18 The Invitation of Bids, the terms and conditions of the E-Auction, Bid of the Successful bidder, Letter / Email Confirmation / Acceptance issued by the Buyer (APSCSCL) to the successful bidder (here in after called the seller)along with any amendment issued prior to signing of contract shall constitute the Contract between the Seller and Buyer.

8.19. The bidders will be charged a non-refundable amount Processing charges of **Rs. 3,000.00 per bidder per commodity** and applicable Service Tax by Tender Wizard. All the registered suppliers who wish to participate on the e-auction shall comply with terms and conditions of e-auction.

8.20. The successful bidder upon receipt of communication regarding acceptance of bid by Tender Wizard shall arrange SD(Security Deposit) an amount equivalent to 10% (Five per cent) of the value of the order as security deposit within 1 (one) working day by way of electronic fund transfer to any of the Tender Wizard in favour of VC&MD, APSCSCL, Hyderabad with Yes Bank. EMD of 2% will be adjusted.

### **9. ORDER FOR SUPPLIES**

9.1. The short listed suppliers who qualify in e-auction for each destination will be issued with Supply orders / indents by Corporation. The Supply order to the supplier will be issued subject to payment of prescribed security deposit with the Exchange account.

9.2. The Corporation does not guarantee the minimum quantity, which will be ordered. It reserves the right to order for only such quantity as may be necessary or required by the respective district and the qualified supplier is bound to supply the ordered quantity at the designated MLS Points spread across the concerned district.

9.3. Quantities supplied in excess of the quantity specified in the supply order will not be paid for. Supply of required quantity should be as indented by the Corporation .Corporation at his sole discretion may place Supply orders/indents by FAX/LETTER/E-MAIL. The successful qualified supplier is bound to honor such indents and shall arrange to supply requisite quantity of Whole Meal Wheat Atta in 1 Kg PP Bag to the designated MLS Points of the districts of Andhra Pradesh. The supply of consignment ordered shall be delivered in accordance with the supply order/indent. The ordered quantity of sugar as per specifications prescribed should be delivered within 10 or 15 working days .at the APSCSCL MLS Points of 13 districts of Andhra state from the date of final supply order issued by the Corporation .As the stock is very urgently required and to ensure uninterrupted supply to the Public Distribution system , the APSCSCL is very keen in getting the stock within the stipulated time and may reduce the delivery time to 10 working days also while issuing supply order. Hence the delivery schedule fixed by the APSCSCL should be kept up at any cost.

9.4. The suppliers are required to enter into an agreement on Rs100/- non-judicial stamp paper to fulfill the contractual obligations as specified by the APSCSCL within 3 days. Deposit of SD (Security Deposit) should be done in to TENDERWIZARD. Agreement with alterations to clauses of the agreement will not be accepted and will be deemed as non-submission of agreement and violation of the terms and conditions of Tender.

9.5. Violation of any of the Clause/Clauses of the Agreement shall be deemed as violation of Terms and Conditions of Tender.

9.6. Security Deposit and EMD furnished by the qualified suppliers will be returned on request upon completion of the contract period or the extended period, if any, subject to satisfactory performance or execution of the contract as per the Terms and Conditions of Tender.

9.7. Non acceptance of supply order / indents within 2 days of declaration of e-auction results will amount to forfeiture of EMD (margin money) deposited along with blacklisting from participating in the subsequent e-auctions for a period of three years.

9.8. Default in supplies either wholly or partly on account of quality or quantity or delay in supply will result in forfeiture of security deposit and EMD (margin money).

9.9. At any stage of supplies under the scheme; if it is noticed that the supplies are not in conformity with the specifications prescribed, such materials are liable to be rejected and qualified supplier will be called upon to make good the same. In the event of qualified supplier failing to make good the rejected stocks, the security Deposit and EMD (margin money) furnished by the qualified supplier shall be forfeited and Corporation is entitled to collect liquidated damages if any from the tender for his failure to comply with the terms and conditions of the tender .

10.6. The successful supplier should supply of Whole Meal Wheat Atta in 1 Kg Manufacturer brand in Secondary 50 Kg PP bag to be delivered to the MLS Points of the districts of Andhra Pradesh State.

10.7. All information as per standards of Weights & Measures Act, 1976 & the Standards of Weights & Measures (Packaged Commodities) Rules, 1977 and Food Safety & Standards Act, 2006 and Regulations there under, must be mentioned on each Polywoven Bag /Jute bag e.g. name and full address of Whole Meal Wheat Atta Manufacturer / Packer, Name of the commodity, gross weight, net weight, month & year of packing of the commodity.

## **11. TERMS OF PAYMENT.**

11.1 After satisfactory supply of the tendered items by the Successful Bidder within the stipulated time, Payment will be released by the APSCSCL to the suppliers within 10-15 working days from date of submission of bills with relevant documents to the APSCSCL. As per the procedure stipulated the amount will be transferred to respective account of the supplier by electronic fund transfer .

1. MLS Point wise Truck-wise Details.(Truck No., Invoice No, Date and Quantity)
2. Invoices.

3. Quality Test Report
4. Any other relevant document issued by the District Officer.

## **12. PENALTY ON DEFAULT/EXTENSION TIME :**

12.1) The entire ordered quantity of **Whole Meal Wheat Atta** should be supplied within the stipulated time. No extension of time will be granted for supply of **Whole Meal Wheat Atta** beyond the specified date fixed.

But in exceptional circumstances and if it is sufficiently proved that the delay in supply is due to the circumstances beyond the control of the suppliers, extension of time will be granted at the discretion of the Purchase Committee subject to the following conditions:

- A) A penalty of Rs. 50/- (Rupees fifty only) will be imposed per MT per day subject to maximum of Rs.500/- per MT per day for the quantity of Whole Meal Wheat Atta supplied after the due date fixed in the supply order.
- B) Supply of stock less than the ordered quantity is not permitted. If the ordered quantity is not supplied in full, the Security Deposit will be forfeited besides blacklisting.
- C) In the event of failure to supply the ordered quantity, by the successful tenderer(s) within the stipulated time, the VC&MD, APSCSC reserves the right to cancel the orders for the unsupplied quantity and place orders with the remaining supplier(s) for the supply of the said quantity or purchase the unsupplied quantity through limited tender system/e-Auction at the risk and cost of such supplier(s) and such supplier(s) is liable and responsible to make good the financial loss sustained by the Corporation. If the rate is cheaper the benefit will not accrue to the supplier(s).
- D) In the event of failure by the successful L1, tenderer(s) the Corporation is at liberty and also reserves the right to purchase the ordered quantity by calling tenders or open Market or has the discretion to re auction the desired quantity through Tenderwizard to ensure uninterrupted supplies. In such circumstances the differential cost, transport charges, incidental charges and other excess

expenditure, if any, will be recovered from the successful L1 tenderer(s). If the rate is cheaper the benefit will not accrue to the supplier.

- E)** At the time of delivery of stocks by the suppliers, the stocks will be subjected to quality verification by the quality control staff of the APSCSCL at the unloading godowns. Samples will be drawn as per the usual procedure of the APSCSCL. **In the event of supply of stocks not confirming to specifications as indicated , such stocks are liable for rejection, and will be viewed seriously besides imposing of Rs 2.00 lakhs Penalty for each truck . - G) Not with standing anything contained in the terms and conditions of this tender the VC&MD, APSCSCL is the ultimate authority in deciding the recovery of penalty from the supplier(s) taking into account the stock position and future requirement of supply in the larger interest of the Corporation.
- H) In the event of failure by the tenderer (s) at any stage of tender process , the EMD and Security Deposit or bills of supplied quantity will be forfeited and Corporation may also proceed with blacklisting of the firm .

### **13. CANCELLATION OF AGREEMENT:-**

- (1) The supplier, if breaches any condition or clause of the agreement the Corporation is entitled to cancel the agreement and also entitled to demand and recover the loss incurred to it due to such cancellation/termination of the agreement.

- (2) If the Government scheme is closed or partly revised or modified, due to accidental decision of State/Central Government or any amendment and the proceedings of purchase is stopped or revised or modified by the Corporation then the agreement will automatically come to an end or partly continues for which supplier is not entitled to demand/receive any type of loss amount or cannot initiate any legal proceedings against APSCSCL

#### **14.FORCE MAJEURE:**

The terms and conditions hereof shall be subject to force majeure. Neither the Corporation nor the supplier shall be considered in default in the performance of their respective obligations herein above if such performance is prevented or delayed because of act of God, War, Flood, Hostilities, Revolution, Civil Commotion, Official Strike, Epidemic, Accident or Fire, or because of Law and Order Proclamation, regulation or ordinance of any Govt. of any Subdivision thereof or local authority. The supplier shall be entitled to the benefit of this clause only if he informs in writing of the circumstances amounting to force majeure to the Corporation for each consignment/ dispatch separately within 48 hours of the happening thereof by telegram and fax immediately followed by a confirmatory letter sent by Regd. Post Acknowledgment due. In the event of the supplier pleading any ground as constituting force majeure, the opinion of the management of the Corporation on that behalf alone shall prevail and, if in the opinion of the management, the grounds pleaded by the supplier do not amount to force majeure, then supplier shall not be entitled to plead the same and or claim any relief under this clause.

#### **15. ARBITRATION:**

Resolution of Disputes:

15.1 In case of any disputes relating to tender including the interpretation of any of the Clause/Clauses of the tender, the matter shall be referred to VC & Managing Director, APSCSC LTD., In case if disputes are not resolved then matter may be referred to Commissioner of Civil Supplies, APSCSC Ltd, Government of Andhra Pradesh who will be the appellate authority.

15.2 In case of any disputes still not resolved and which are relating to supply of Whole Meal Wheat Atta including the interpretation of any of the Clause/Clauses of this Tender, the matter shall be referred to a sole arbitrator not less than the rank of Secretary to Government of Andhra

Pradesh, appointed by the Government. The remuneration for the arbitrator shall be fixed by the Government. The arbitration shall be held in Hyderabad and the decision of the arbitrator shall be final and binding on both parties to the arbitration. The arbitration will be conducted in accordance with arbitration and conciliation Act, 1996.

15.3 Court situated in Hyderabad to the exclusion of all other courts in India, only shall have the jurisdiction in the matter.

**16 CORRUPT PRACTICES:**

Any bribe, commission, advantages offered or promised by or on behalf of the supplier to any officer/ employee/ servant of the APSCSC Ltd, then such Suppliers shall be debarred from the tender enquiry in addition to initiating criminal action and blacklisting. Canvassing in any form on the part of the Supplier or on his behalf at any stage of tender process or while giving delivery will be treated as violation of terms and conditions of tender. If such instances are noticed the Supplier will be blacklisted for a minimum period of 3 years.

**17 INDEMNITY:**

The Supplier shall defend, indemnify and hold Buyer harmless during and after the tender against any and all liabilities, damages, claims, fines, penalties, actions, procedures and expenses of any nature arising out of, resulting from any violation of any laws by the Supplier or its punishment or any way connected with the acts, negligence, breach, failure to perform obligations relating to the tender.

**18. Jurisdiction**

All Civil suits arising by this agreement should be subject to the jurisdiction of the City Civil Court, Hyderabad only.

## **6.QUALITY PARAMETERS.**

### **6.1QUALITY SPECIFICATIONS OF WHOLE MEAL WHEAT ATTA**

Wheat Atta should conform to the provisions of the FSS Act and Rules/Regulations. Atta or resultant Atta means the coarse product obtained by milling or grinding clean wheat free from pest, rodent hair and excreta.

Whole Meal Wheat Atta shall have a characteristic taste and smell and be fit in all respects for human consumption. It shall conform to the following standards.

1. Moisture : Not more than 13% (when determined by heating at 130-133 Degrees Centigrade for 2 hours)
2. Total Ash ( on dry basis ) : Not more than 2%
3. Ash insoluble in dilute HCL : Not more than 0.15% on dry weight basis
4. Gluten (on dry weight basis) : Not Less than 6%
5. Alcoholic Acidity with 90% alcohol Expressed as H<sub>2</sub>SO<sub>4</sub>(on weight basis) : Not more than 0.18%
6. Sieve test with 62 GG or 275 mm size : 30 gms to 35 gms(grittiness)per Kg
7. It shall be free from rodent hair and excreta.
8. Shall be free from insect infestation, fungus infection and other impurities.

Only good quality of whole meal wheat Atta under the FSSA, 2006 Rules & Regulations strictly conforming to the specifications as detailed above will be accepted.

Stocks not conforming to specifications shall stand summarily rejected and it is the responsibility of the supplier/Tenderer to take back the rejected stocks within no time immediately and replace them with stocks of required quality specification at his own risk and cost.
